Re: Remote Learning

As our second week in this unprecedented situation draws to a close I wanted to take this opportunity to remind both parents and pupils how important it is to try and maintain some sort of routine. Whilst we are no wiser on how long this situation may continue, what is clear is that pupils need to try and maintain some consistency so that the transition back to school life, or into college is as smooth as possible.

With this in mind we are asking all parents/carers to ensure that your child is up and available to take our calls by 10.30am. These phone calls are important for us to be able to give your child educational support and to also help you support your child's mental health during this time.

Our staff continue to put the educational and well-being needs at the forefront and are continuing to plan lessons and resources that pupils can complete whilst at home. These resources are being upload onto the Show My Homework app and in some cases emailed directly to pupils.

Can you please check that your child has now accessed their email and logged onto SMHW? If you require log in details again please contact us as soon as possible.

You will also receive today additional attachments including an 'Active Coping Calendar' and government guidance 'Looking after your feelings and body', and a link to 'Worry and Anxiety about Coronavirus'. All easy read resources with suggestions on how to cope during this time.

As stated in the previous letter, the government advice to schools continues to advise that we should remain open unless advised by Public Health England not to, therefore presently we have no plans to close.
